
## DAY ONE- 26th of February 2017

- Introduce WHO's Heath-in-All-Polices framework for Country Action.






## DAY TWO- 27th of February 2017

- Demonstrate the link between the process of policy development and the Sustainable Development Goals.






## CONT. DAY TWO- 27th of February 2017

Discuss the critical role of key players in Heath-in-All-Polices, including governments, civil society and private sector.




## **DAY THREE- 28th of February 2017**
