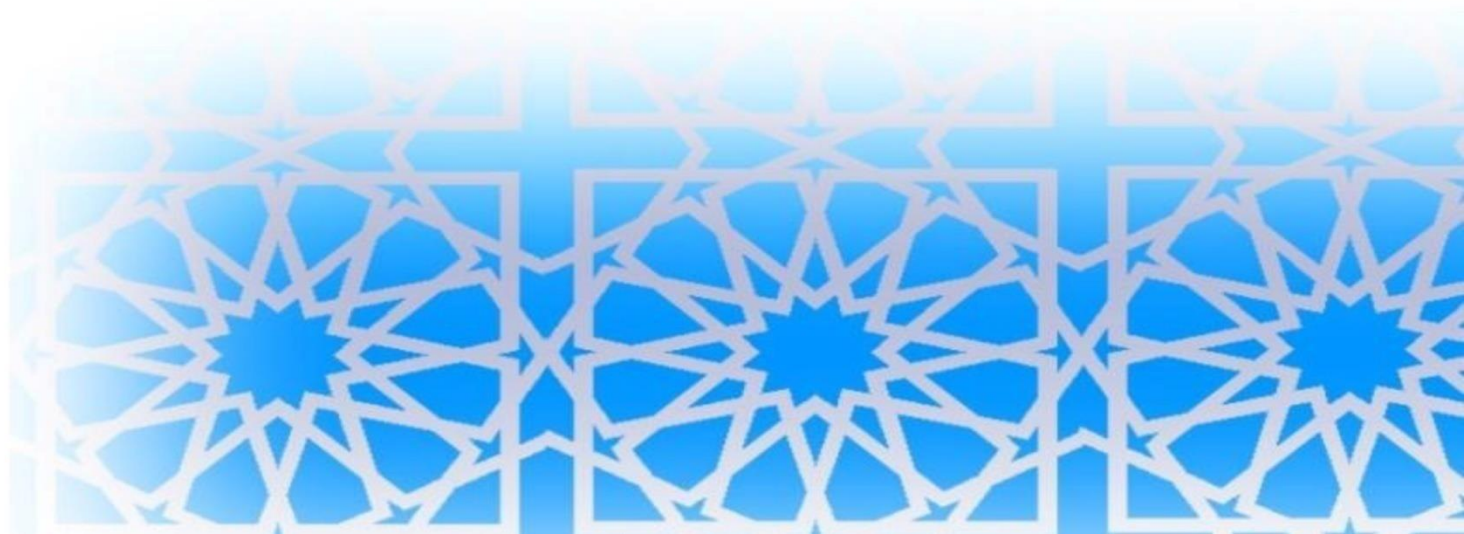

- ❖ **Political commitment and leadership**
- ❖ **Health and social issues are not prioritized**
- ❖ **Concept** easily understood but **implementation** is a challenge
- ❖ **New institutional arrangements**
- ❖ **Health sector reform**
 - ✓ Re-structuring of MOH
 - ✓ New competencies
- ❖ **Role of Parliament:** legislation, budget, oversight

Common messages

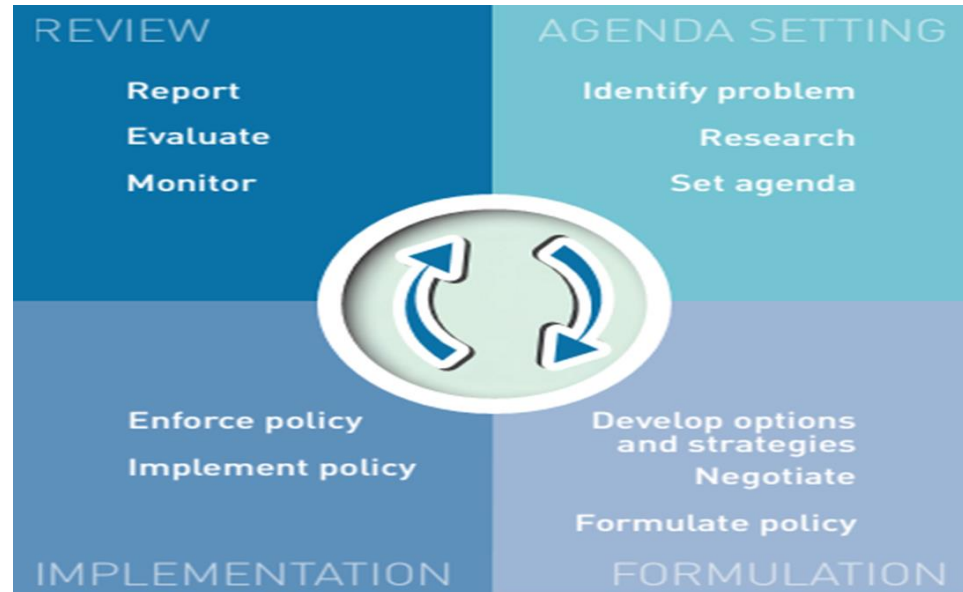
- ❖ **Overarching bodies:** essential power and autonomy to exercise their expected roles
- ❖ **Engagement of stakeholders from the outset:** common vision and stronger ownership
- ❖ **Civil society role** is important but their work needs to be interconnected
- ❖ **Efforts do exist**, though fragmented, and can be built on for further action
- ❖ **Sustainability issues**
- ❖ **Global and regional partnerships**

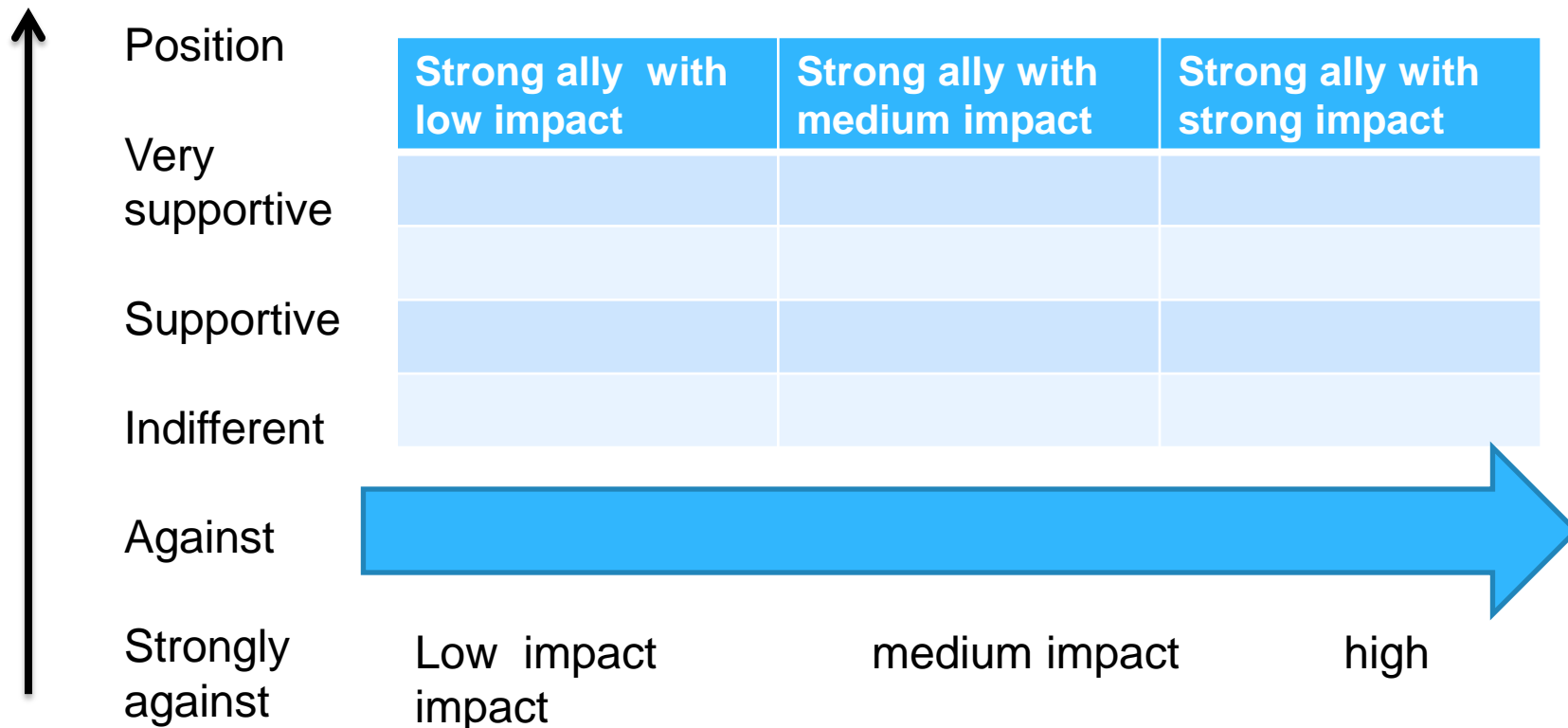
